Recruitment Extension and Discussions with NIHR

We are currently in discussion with the NIHR to agree on adjustments to the primary outcome. This would allow us to adjust our overall **sample size** and will mean a potential **extension to the original study timelines** in order to achieve this adjusted sample size. We will communicate the final decision with you as soon as possible. This will not result in any changes to data collection, etc.

A non-substantial amendment (NSA 19Mar2024) was recently distributed to teams and their R&Ds to extend recruitment by 6 months to 31st January 2025, while the NIHR review the sample size options we have submitted to them. Please ensure your R&D teams are aware of this extension to recruitment and please let us know if you require any additional support to achieve your recruitment targets.
