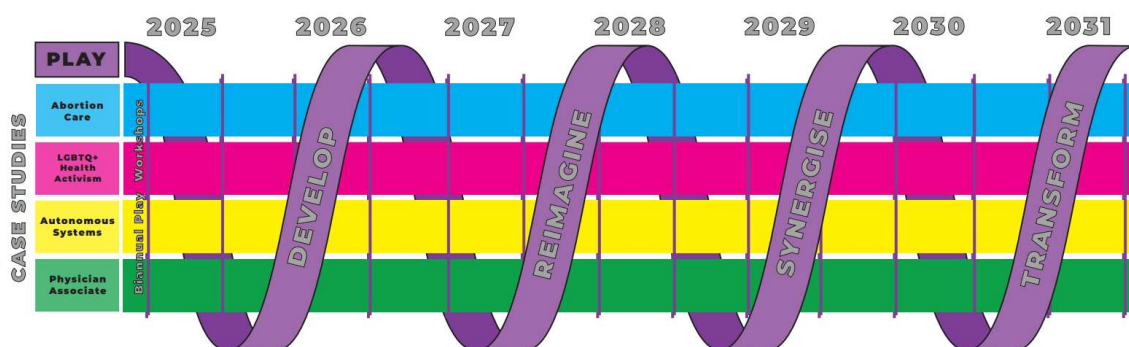

Four case-studies will investigate whose authority, needs and values emerge when the doctor is de-centred, and which are neglected and lost.

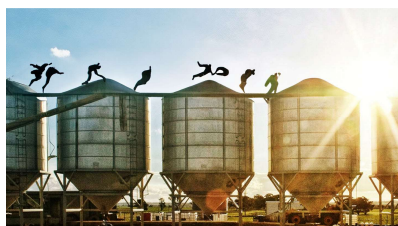
### MEDICINE WITHOUT DOCTORS REIMAGINING CARE AND VOICE THROUGH PLAY TIMELINE
