Anticipal search run on practice records

AT START (BASELINE)

- EXTRACT INITIAL PATIENT COHORT
- COMPLETE + SEND DATA SUMMARY

AFTER 12 WEEKS (FINAL)

- FINAL DATASET FOR PATIENT COHORT
- COMPLETE + SEND DATA SUMMARY



Research Team

- Support practice to run Anticipal search.
- Analyse anonymised Anticipal cohort data
 - Patient demographics
 - Anticipal results
 - Number with KIS & ACP record
 - Number on palliative care register.

4ACP research & implementation

AT START

- 'THINKING ALOUD' INTERVIEW (x1) ON PATIENT IDENTIFICATION FOR ACP.

DURING CASE STUDY

- OFFER NHS INFORM RESOURCES TO PATIENTS.

AT END (12 WEEKS)

- REVIEW 'ANTICIPAL' LIST
- 'REFLECTIVE' INTERVIEWS ABOUT ACP (x2-3).



Research Team

- Support one practice GP to review Anticipal list generated by records search.
- Interview one GP 'thinking aloud' about screening and identification for ACP.
- Interview 1-2 key staff about experiences of ACP.

4ACP Patient research

- IDENTIFY 1-2 PATIENTS/RESIDENTS AFTER A RECENT ACP CONVERSATION
- INVITE PATIENT/RESIDENT +FAMILY (IF INVOLVED) TO THINK ABOUT AN INTERVIEW TO TALK ABOUT THEIR EXPERIENCES OF ACP.
- SEND CONSENT TO CONTACT DETAILS TO RESEARCH TEAM



Research Team

- Provide practices with ACP prompt cards and links to Scottish ACP resources.
- Contact interested patient/resident/family.
- Discuss study and obtain formal consent.
- Inform practice of participation.
- Interview participants.

Review ACP outcomes (At end)

- COLLATE SUMMARY OF CARE PLANNING ACTIONS FOR COHORT.
- WITH INTERVIEWED PATIENT CONSENT, SEND KIS SUMMARY AND RELEVANT CLINICAL INFORMATION TO RESEARCH TEAM.
